First of all, you're not asking the right question...

[Most people forget to question whether they are asking the right question. Instead they are on a quest to find the perfect answer to their wrong question.]

First, I'll answer your question...

It's very likely that she would respond favorably to this...

Reason #1. 99% of girls/women have a "jealousy button"
Reason #2. You're operating within her "model of the world". You're using her flawed & unflawed beliefs/concepts/viewpoints...

In simple terms...

It's kind of like telling a very young girl new facts about Santa Claus. (in an effort to get her to DO SOMETHING...which would be 100 times easier than first convincing her that Santa isn't real...)

This is what a lot of guys do in their interactions with women...

They suck at stepping into her world...

As a result, they suck at creating a DEEP Connection.

And as a result, they suck at driving her sexual tension to new levels...

So if you tell a little girl new facts about Santa, she processes it and matches it with her existing information about Santa (in a world where Santa is real and has done a bunch of cool things...)

By the way, I don't know how skilled you are with women or if you're able to think 3 levels ahead, but (without getting into specifics) using her "model of the world" is a powerful way to understand a woman better and demonstrate a "deep connective understanding" that's unlike anything she's ever experienced...

(If you have a copy of Super Attraction Power, re-read it immediately while "using her model of the world" is fresh on your mind to get some ideas... or at least SKIM through it...)

That's a good idea [Albert]...changing it a bit.. like the evil woman technique...

...or you could directly use the *emotions of her experience* to 'paint the picture' of what YOU experienced...

...that way you can be sure you create the right affect...

Here's an example to show how simple this can be...

You: Do you remember when you told me about your 'love at first sight' experience

Her: Yeah

You: I think I may have experienced it but I'm not sure

Her: Really

You: Let me ask you since you experienced it before.

Her: OK

You: Where do you feel the sensation in your body?

Her: Like in my stomach

You: YEAH!! it's like a sensation that you kind of feel *IIINNNNNNN* your stomach. What was going through your mind when you saw the other person?

Her: I don't know... it was like I was in love with him for a long time...

You: EXACTLY.. it's like you've been DEEPLY IN LOVE for longer than just a few seconds.

You get the idea.

It's kind of like what 'fake psychics' do...

fake psychic: Your (dead) grandfather wants to know what's in the attic?

person: i don't know.

fake psychic: think! it's important!

person: ... ummm...the family photo album???? I've been meaning to bring it down, but I've been so busy.

fake psychic: he's telling me that you need to bring it down NOW!!!... because pictures of your love ones are in there.

person: OK. I will. (crying)

The person tells someone a few days later.... *I met this psychic who KNEW about my family photo in the attic!!! It could have been anywhere! but he knew! It was creepy...*

So you can take the 'fake psychic approach' except instead of trying to rip her off and steal her money, you're going to connect with her on a deep level [at worse, you're playing a more intelligent tit for tat game]..

You're using her personal experience (including the emotional attachments of it) to ENGRAIN the picture inside of her head...

[BTW, this doesn't suggest that this is the best approach to the situation, but tactically this concept can be used in situations where it is a good idea.]

Personally (and I'm kind of weird this way) but if my girlfriend told me she feel in love with another guy (instantly or gradually) the relationship would be over (instantly)...

I'm fine...

By the way, this is a very good/insightful question... I'm shocked that no one has ever asked it (at least in the way you have)

The answer is based on something I never taught (directly) which is the concept of "levels/types of tension"...

If you understand this, it's a TOTAL game-changer...

It's a good thing to know conceptually because it gives you ONE MORE THING to measure (and pay attention to) with your woman...

Because some women are going to be more responsive to certain types of tension....

In some cases, a massive tension-release (pre-sex) **DESTROYS** sexual tension (for reasons that you obviously understand).

In some cases, a massive tension-release (pre-sex) **CREATES** sexual tension.

A lot of this has to do with complimentary signals.... or 'the other ingredients in the recipe of arousal'....

It's the reason why 'complimenting your wife' about how sexy she looks **SOMETIMES** works (increases sexual tension) and **SOMETIMES** it doesn't work (decreases sexual tension)

Here's another perspective...

For example, if you look at **the structure of Make Up Sex...** (and I use this example because most guys have a concept of it...and it's a great example of a sequence of events/emotions that lead to 'massive sexual arousal'...

..the BASIC sequence is normally something like:

"hate/anger/disconnection" followed by **"renewed-love/relief-of-emotional-stress/reassurance"** ...

...as you can probably see, there's a massive tension release that takes place and it ends up creating massive sexual tension (an INSTANT surge of sexual tension in some cases)...

...which in some ways is weird (or contradictory)...

Right?

Because you would think that if you RELEASE the tension (in the form of her thinking 'Wow. It feels good that we're not arguing anymore!') then it would fizzle out sexual tension....

But that typically doesn't happen....

So...

What's ACTUALLY happening?

The best way to understand this... is to think about what happens during sexual intercourse or when you 'eat her pussy'...

Metaphorically... if you are licking a woman's vagina until she is squirming with pleasure, one thing you would notice is that she's enjoying herself...

If you were to suddenly stop, what's going to be going through her mind?

She's going to be thinking "What's wrong? Why did you stop? Pleeeeeeeeeeeeeeeease keep going." (LOL)

Right?

If you were to then continue, you would have just released a 'certain [not all] amount of tension' (WITHIN a tension environment)...

In other words, on her end there's this momentary feeling/relief of "Wow. I'm glad he continued"....

YET she hasn't had a COMPLETE release of tension (i.e. an orgasm)...which means there was lingering tension...

So on her end there's this massive tension-release as your tongue reconnects with her....and that INCREASES THE URGE to have a "total (or a more complete/desired) tension release" (i.e. an orgasm)...

Does this make sense?

That's the structure you want to follow when you're getting a woman horny...

Again: If you look at "make up sex" in jealousy environments... there's often two streams of sexual tension at work...

"Hate/anger" [Stream #1] + Not-good-enough/not-pretty-enough" [Stream #2] followed by....

"Renewed-love/relief-of-emotional-stress/happy [Tension Release Stream #1] + Feeling-of-beauty/feeling-of-value" [Tension Release Stream #2]

Many unhealthy relationships have this kind of structure... the guy cheats on his woman...and then sweet talks her and suddenly she goes from feeling "not-attractive-enough & unwanted" to "Pretty & Loved" ...

[For all the Wide-Eyed Rookies out there at getting women horny, make sure you remember that all women enjoy feeling pretty & loved]

The idea of course is to understand, respect & appreciate a woman's desire to feel love, pretty (and other things)....

You don't have to (and shouldn't) resort to reckless behavior as a means of pressing her buttons...
