I purchased the program and have read all of the materials. My gf has been out of town over the weekend with friends so I wanted to use the opportunity to improve and figure some new things out.

Hey [Keith]

First of all, I understand exactly how you feel... one minute you're the man.. you're confident and in control...things are going great/perfect with a hot new girl who is into you and out of nowhere it feels like it's slipping away...

It's not a good feeling...

Based on the information you provided, there's a few possibilities....

But first I think when most people find themselves in a situation they begin searching for answers to their questions.

Instead they should be searching for the right questions (first).

Whenever a guy is a relationship problem, there are two types of questions that he should ask.

Type 1 Questions: What have I done to create this? Do I need to make any adjustments? What type of adjustments do I need to make?

Type 2 Questions: Is her behavior acceptable? Is she the type of woman I want to be with? Is she capable of changing? Is she likely to ever change?

With that said, there are typically 4 scenarios:

- Guys who are in a Type 2 situation, asking Type 1 questions....
- Guys who are in a Type 1 situation, asking Type 2 questions....
- Guys who are in a Type 2 situation, asking Type 2 questions....
- Guys who are in a Type 1 situation, asking Type 1 questions....

Again, I think all guys should be asking both questions (when the relationship and/or sex life takes a nose-drive)

People need to be on a quest for: What's really going on? (The rare guy who asks Type 1 and Type 2 Questions)

I let me wife read your email (to get a female's perspective and an additional perspective) and her EYES GOT WIDE... she even threw out the possibility that she was being nice in the beginning just to secure shelter...

As far as your situation, you have to be *more* in a mindset of **trying to figure out what's going on** and **what type of person you're dealing with...**

More so than **What can I do to get things back to how they were?** (which is the natural response)...

What you need to do (gameplan-wise) is going to be based on: What's going on?

What kind of mistakes were you making? [Type 1 Situation]

What type of person you're dealing with? [Type 2 Situation]

Your situation is still kind of new...

She doesn't seem ready to "grow up" (or capable of "growing up") and there's not really anything you can do about it...

Everyone runs into unavoidable circumstances... the question is "how much of her behavior & outlook on life" lead to her problem (losing her home plus job)...

I know you're being supportive, but there should be a part of you that's evaluating **her behavior patterns**...

(( The operative word being 'pattern' ))

When it comes to "figuring out" what's going on, DO NOT base it on what she says...pay attention to the FACTS, HER BEHAVIOR...

She has a child...a 3 year old little boy...She's in a relationship with a guy who was nice enough to take her in along with her kid...

And She's off partying and not coming home when she said she would. Plus she's being less affectionate towards you.

That is 100% unacceptable! That is beyond disrespectful!

You seem like you were polite when you asked her: "When are you coming home?"

And she responded "Are you alright?" ...That almost sounds like she is oblivious to why you would ask that question....

the scariest part of reading your email was the part where she said "are you alright?"...

Hopefully, she's not a **TAKER**

- a **TAKER** doesn't have the ability to appreciate.
- a **TAKER** will tell you they appreciate what you do, but they don't show it.

- a TAKER makes decisions that benefits their short-term pleasure at the expensive of people who care about them..

Plus she's being disrespectful to you?

I'm a big believer in: "You tend to get a lot of information about a person based on how they handle tough situations"...

You have to logically sort things out...

You're going to have to make a serious "perspective" adjustment...

You may mean doing things that you're not comfortable with doing...

You're a responsible guy. Smart and Witty. You have a house. Car. You've proven that you have the ability to attract hot women. You have a heart. You're respectful & understanding.

You have to start remembering who are. Those things put you at the top. You're a high quality guy!

1. Start rebuilding your Sexual Value with the basics - remember who you are and having much higher standards for what is acceptable and unacceptable behavior...
2. Then observe how she reacts.
